

### **RULES & REGULATIONS**

#### **GENERAL RULES**

• ENTRIES: Please complete your entries online at www.HorseShowing.com by Tuesday, Oct. 1, 2024. No mail, phone, fax, or hand-delivered entries will be accepted. (DO NOT enter for USHJA Zone 3 Championship. Letters of invitation will be mailed by the end of September.) For entry questions, contact: Beverly Abbott, bevabbott2575@gmail.com The charge for post entries is \$50 per horse for any entry not received on or before the closing date on October 1, 2024.

Please read the short Horseshowing.com user's guide for handy tips to help you easily navigate the online entry system.

- ILLNESS: Should a horse/pony or rider become ill or injured before Oct. 8, 2024 entry fees, if paid in advance, will be refunded, less a \$60 office charge, upon receipt of a veterinarian's or doctor's letter. No refunds will be made after the closing date. Substitution of horse/pony or rider will be allowed.
- TICKETED WARM-UP: Wednesday, Oct. 16, 10:00 a.m. 6:00 p.m. Fee: \$30 per ticket. Tickets may be purchased in the Horse Show office. Back number must be worn in the ring.
- AWARDS: Eight ribbons will be awarded in each class. Division champions will receive a cooler or pillow and championship ribbon.
- STABLING: Stabling will be available for \$275 per stall (\$300 if reserved after Oct. 1). Stalls will be available Wednesday, Oct. 16, after 8:00 a.m. and must be vacated by the close of the show on Sunday, Oct. 20.
  - Stalls are 10'x10' vinyl with doors on bluestone pads under tents
  - Sharps Containers will be placed in stabling area. Competition Management may fine any individual up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.
- GROUNDS FEE: A \$45 grounds fee will be charged to entries not stabled at Salem Farm Showgrounds. Hunter Breeding entries are exempt from grounds fee.
- NON-NEGOTIABLE CHECKS may disqualify an entry and the exhibitor will be charged a \$50 collection fee. Exhibitors with outstanding debts to WIHS will not be allowed to compete.
- CLASS SIZE: Management reserves the right to combine sections if there are insufficient entries. In all sections, the number of entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: A current negative Coggins test must be presented along with certificates of vaccination. Pursuant to USEF GR-845 all horses must have certificate of vaccination for EIV and EHV within 6 months of the start of the competition.
- VETERINARIAN: During the show, the veterinarian's telephone number will be posted in the show office.
- HORSE OWNERSHIP: The owner listed on the entry blank must be the owner listed on the horse's USHJA registration papers or provide proof of ownership or lease.

**Smoking** is not permitted on the the grounds of Salem Farm Showgrounds.



**Equine Ambulance** A \$12 fee for the equine ambulance will be added to each entry.



WIHS is not responsible for errors and/or omissions in the prize list.



**Courtesy** Management reserves the right to decline any entry or return any entry fees before or during the show, without being liable for damages. Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to any judge or official by an owner, rider, trainer or groom shall disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit all entry fees.



**REMINDER:** It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper, or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured (GR801).

#### **USHJA ZONE 3 CHAMPIONSHIP**

- Letters of invitation to compete in USHJA Zone 3 Championship will be emailed/mailed the end of September.
   Approximately the top 20 horses in each section, based on total USEF zone points, will be invited. The qualifying period includes shows starting on or after September 1, 2023, through shows starting on or before August 31, 2024.
   Exhibitors will be given one week to accept the invitation. If invitations are not accepted, additional horses will be invited.
- Horses, ponies and riders participating in the USHJA Zone 3 Championship on Sunday also may compete in the WIHS Regional Horse Show on Thursday, Friday and Saturday.
- See Zone 3 specifications on page 36.
- All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Manners and suitability of horse/ pony to rider shall be emphasized and extreme speed shall be penalized. Under saddle classes will be shown at a walk, trot and canter in both directions of the ring.
- Champion and reserve champion will be awarded to two of the four entries accumulating the most points over
  fences in each hunter section. In addition to these points, only these four entries shall receive points for ribbons won
  in one under saddle class (per USEF Rule HU138). If there is a tie for a Grand Hunter Champion, the tie breaker will
  be the entry with the most points over fences. If still tied, The Grand Hunter Champion will be the entry earning the
  highest numerical cumulative score in the over fences in the division.
- All riders competing in adult amateur classes must have a current amateur certification from USEF. This rule applies to all adult amateur riders whether they are members or non-members of USEF.
- All ponies competing in pony classes must have a current measurement card or measurement certification issued by USEF or be measured at the show. Please see show office for measurement date.
- There is no nominating fee for jumpers. The class entry fee must be paid by the close of entries, October 1, 2024.
   Late entries will be accepted only on a space-available basis. If late entries are accepted, an additional \$50 late fee will be charged.
- All riders competing in adult amateur classes must have a current amateur certification from USEF, whether they are members or non-members of USEF.
- Jumpers tied for other than first place will be placed based on their first round time unless otherwise indicated.

#### **REGIONAL SHOW AND QUALIFYING CLASSES**

- All classes, including qualifying classes for the WIHS Championship at The Show Place Arena, are open to all horses
  and ponies regardless of geographical location. Owner listed on the entry blank must be the owner listed on horse's
  USEF/USHJA registration papers or provide proof of ownership or lease.
- The overall WIHS Regional Horse Show Children's and Adult Hunter champions will qualify to compete in the WIHS Children's or Adult Hunter Championships at The Show Place Arena.
- The overall WIHS Regional Horse Show Children's and Adult Amateur Jumper champions will qualify to compete in the WIHS Children's or Adult Jumper Championships at The Show Place Arena.
- Riders competing at the WIHS Regional Horse Show, October 17-20, 2024, at the Salem Farm Showgrounds, will
  qualify for the WIHS Regional Finals at the Show Place Arena as follows: the top five in each pony hunter section,
  the top four in each children's hunter and adult hunter sections. Horses and ponies to be owned by exhibitors living
  within 100 miles of Washington, DC, based on owner's zip code. Owner listed on the entry blank must be the owner
  listed on the horse's USHJA registration papers or provide proof of ownership or lease.

The top 20 point earners qualify for the finals to be held at The Warrenton Pony Show

#### VHSA/EMO CHILDREN'S MEDAL

Class 82, Fee: \$40

Open to Junior members of VHSA who have not reached their 18th birthday. Riders may not compete in any class where the fence height exceeds 3', 3" (1.0m) with the exception of the Childrens/Adult Jumper division, at the same show, where a rider may not jump higher than 3'9" (1.15m). Contestant must be a member of VHSA prior to entry in the class according to Article II, 3. Open to horses only. To be shown over a course of not less than six obstacles at 3', which must include one combination and two changes of direction. All VHSA Medal Class courses must have at least two of the following inside the course: a roll back turn, a broken or bending line, an end jump, a narrow jump, or a long ride to a single jump. This also applies to the show hosting the VHSA Adult/Children's Hunter Medal Finals. The judge must call back at least four exhibitors for further testing over fences. Fall of horse or rider or three disobediences shall eliminate a contender. There must be at least three exhibitors to fill the class and three exhibitors must complete the course in order for that particular class to count. Six Ribbons. This Medal cannot be combined with any other VHSA Medal or any other Division/Class. In the Finals, same testing applies.

#### VHSA ADULT AMATEUR MEDAL

Class 83, Fee: \$40

Open to horses only. Contestant must be a member of VHSA prior to entry in the class according to Article II, 3. and must hold a current amateur card issued by USEF. To be shown over a course of not less than six (6) obstacles at 3', which must include one combination and two changes of direction. All VHSA Medal Class courses must have at least two of the following inside the course: a roll back turn, a broken or bending line, an end jump, a narrow jump, or a long ride to a single jump. Riders may not compete in any class where the fence height exceeds 3'3" (1.0m) with the exception of the Childrens/Adult Jumper division, at the same show, where a rider may not jump higher than 3'9" (1.15m). This also applies to the show hosting the VHSA Adult/Children's Hunter Medal Finals. The judge must call back at least four exhibitors for further testing over fences. Jumping faults of mount not to count. Fall of horse or rider or three disobediences shall eliminate a contender. There must be at least three exhibitors to fill the class and three exhibitors must complete the course in order for that particular class to count. Six Ribbons. This Medal cannot be combined with any other VHSA Medal or any other Division/Class. In the Finals, same testing applies.

MHSA will extend invitations to all Junior Members of the Association who have qualified for this class during the competition year. Letters of invitation will be emailed, please wait for official notification to enter. To be considered timely, your entry for this class must be made by the closing date of the show. The class shall be judged numerically on the performance of rider over eight or more jumps, with wings, 3' in height, seat and hands; guidance and control of the mount throughout the whole course. The course must contain an oxer and at least one change of direction and three of the following which may not be combined: bending line, narrow jump (6'-8'), roll back turn, fence at the end of the ring, long approach to a single. Jumping faults shall not be counted. Numerical scoring will be used. Riders will be eliminated after two refusals in the MHSA Gittings Horsemanship Finals.No less than 10 riders will return on the flat. All riders must show all gaits (walk, trot, and canter) in both directions; as well as lengthening of stride at all working gaits in each direction. This sitting trot should be at a working sitting trot. The counter canter in both directions is required. In addition, the judge must require a minimum of 4 riders to perform additional tests (USEF tests 1-17 – Refer to EQ112).

#### MHSA CHILDREN'S PONY MEDAL

#### Class 81, Fee: \$40 (One fee for both MHSA and VHSA Children's Pony Medal)


Open to Junior riders on ponies. Riders may not compete in MHSA Hunter Seat on Ponies Medal at the same show. To jump 8 fences of hunter type with or without wings. The course must contain an oxer, at least one change of direction, and two of the following which may not be combined: a bending line, a narrow jump (6'-8'), a roll back turn, a fence at the end of the ring, or a long approach to a single fence. No in and out can be used. Small/medium ponies to jump 2', and large ponies to jump 2'6". Exhibitors who lose their junior status as of December 1 shall not be eligible to compete in MHSA Children's Pony Medal classes held after the finals competition during that year. Class to be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control throughout. To fill a class, four riders must complete the course. Only one rider per pony. The MHSA Children's Pony Medal class may be run concurrently with the MHSA Children' Pony Hunter division and the VHSA Children's Pony Medal class. To qualify for MHSA Children's Pony Medal Finals, rider must be a member of MHSA. Those competing at the Finals must be a USEF/USHJA member or pay a USEF/USHJA non-member fee. Rider's pony for the finals must have a USEF Pony Measurement Card.

#### MHSA ADULT AMATEUR MEDAL

Class 85, Fee: \$40

Open to horses and ponies ridden by amateur exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year, and who are MHSA Senior Amateur Members. Members competing in classes restricted to amateurs must meet the requirements of USEF rule GR1306. Your signature as rider on the entry blank and annual membership form will verify that you understand and are in compliance with the rule. If split by age, it shall be split 18 -35 and 36 and older. May be combined with Junior Equitation if there are fewer than four entries. To be judged equally on hands, seat, control and suitability of mount. The fence heights for the over fences class shall be 2'6" and 3'. The flat class is to be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, trot and canter. Additional tests may be required. May be combined with Junior Equitation if there are fewer than four entries.





By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the WIHS Regional Horse Show & USHJA Zone 3 Championship (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4

#### MOTORIZED VEHICLE RULE

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

#### **USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT**

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
